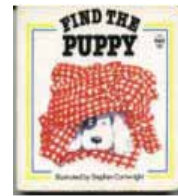
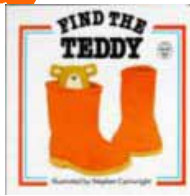

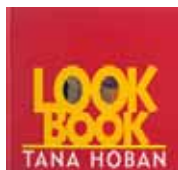
### It's Summertime! By Elaine W. Good Illustrated By Susie Shenk Wenger

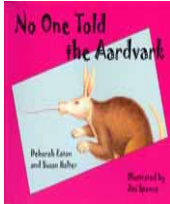

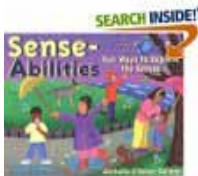

**No One Told the Aardvark** *By Deborah Eaton and Susan Halter Illustrated by Jim Spence*

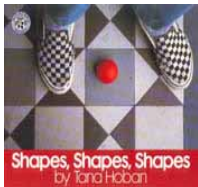

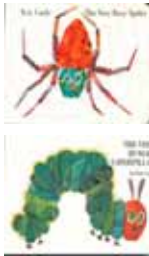
### The House I'll Build For The Wrens *By Nancy Winslow Parker*
